HRS Honors Opportunity List



The following is a list of the categories in which you must achieve a total of 55 points while also maintaining a 3.4 GPA to successfully complete your candidacy and graduate *with honors in HRS*. Included is a list of pre-approved opportunities to accrue these points. The minimum points across the three categories is 50 points, leaving 5 points to be obtained from any combination of the categories based on the student's goals. The Honors Program is intended to demonstrate experiences that go beyond requirements for a Bachelor's Degree, thus points cannot be earned for activities completed as part of the requirements for your degree program.

1. Honors and Graduate Coursework (at least 18 points): points earned by completing the following:
